



You will need;

Card/paper

Paint

Pens/pencils

Scissors

Googly eyes.

Directions

- Do your handprint
- Cut two small circles out of paper to make the eyes.
- Once dry, attach the eyes.
- Add detail of face, teeth, nostrils, knees, toes and tail
- Embellish with decorations if you wish.



You will need;

Card tube/ card/ paper

Directions

- Colour in your card tube.
- Cut out 2 small circles and colour to make ears.
- Cut out and colour two small circles to make the eyes.
- Cut out an oval to make the nose/muzzle.
- Cut out two small circles to make teeth.
- If using paint– leave to dry before assembling.
- Assemble as in the picture above.
- Draw nostrils on the muzzle
- Embellish with decorations if you wish.

Hippo



You will need;

Card or paper

Way to colour in.

Pen/ pencil

Glue/ tape

Scissors

Optional;

Paper plates

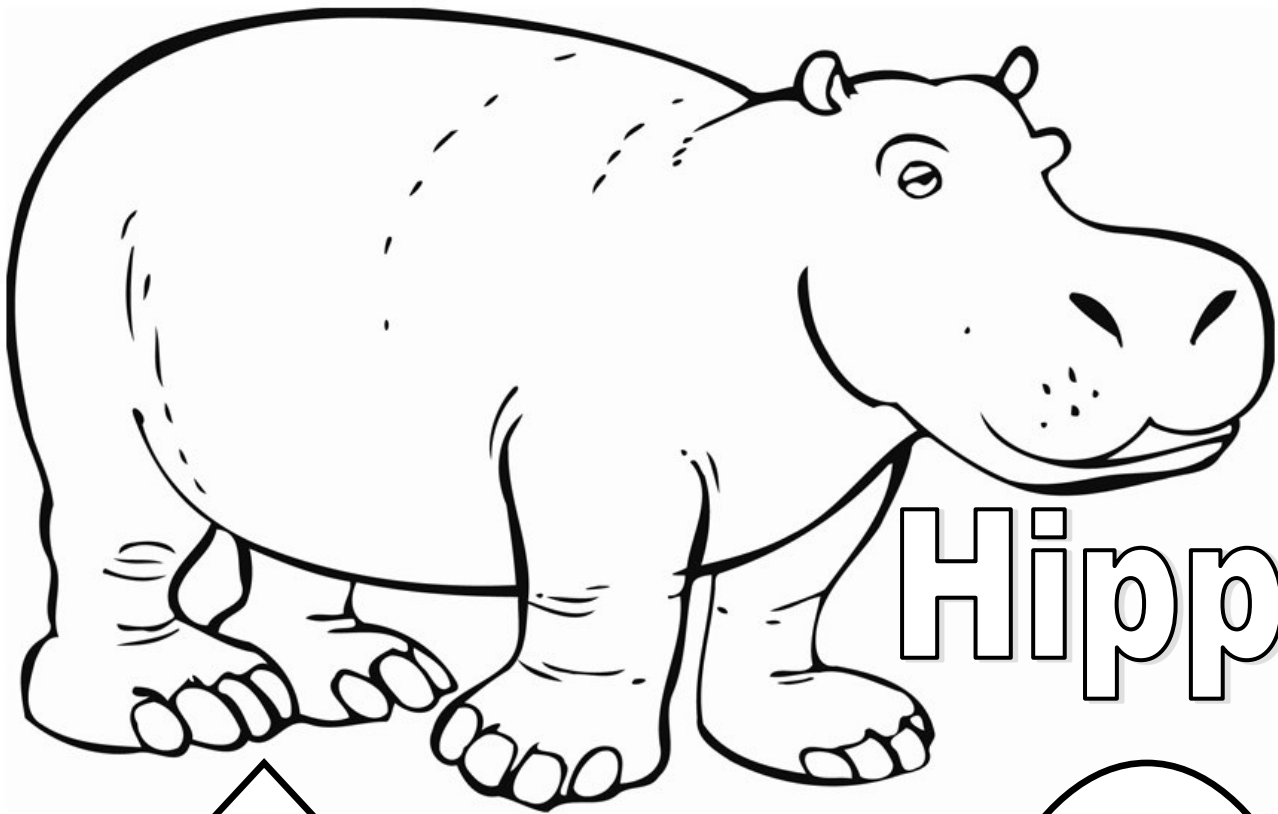
Googly eyes

Other decorations.

Directions

- Colour in the face (paper plate or a piece of card/paper cut to size)
- Fold a second plate/circle in half, colour the top of the fold the same as the face. Colour the whole of the inside pink
- Cut 2 small ovals the same size out of card/paper and colour in pink.
- Cut 2 small circles and colour the same as the face
- Cut out 2 large teeth– rectangles with curved corners.
- Cut out 2 small circles and colour to make eyes
- If using paint– leave to dry before assembling.
- Assemble and glue your hippo as shown in the picture.
- Draw dots for whiskers across the folded circle below the nose.
- Embellish with decorations if you wish.
